

## **SUNEDISON NAMED FOR WAL-MART'S SOLAR POWER PILOT PROJECT**

*North America's Largest Solar Energy Services Provider to build, own and operate rooftop solar power plants for Wal-Mart stores in Hawaii and California.*

Beltsville, MD – May 7, 2007 -- SunEdison, North America largest solar energy services company, today was named the largest provider for a solar power pilot project for Wal-Mart Stores, Inc. (NYSE:WMT). The eight stores, four in California and four in Hawaii, are part of a comprehensive approach to renewable energy adopted by Wal-Mart. Deployment is slated to start immediately, with all locations substantially completed by the end of 2007. The pilot project will determine solar power viability for other Wal-Mart locations.

The solar photovoltaic systems will be deployed with the SunEdison Power Purchase Agreement (PPA) model, whereby customers purchase solar electricity, rather than solar equipment. SunEdison will finance, install, operate and maintain the photovoltaic power plants for Wal-Mart. Under the PPA model, SunEdison only charges customers for electricity produced at rates equal to, or below the customer's existing retail prices. The solar systems are driven entirely by sunlight, are silent, emissions free, highly reliable, and complement existing utility power. Since the solar power plants have no fuel costs, the customer benefits by having long-term predictable energy pricing. SunEdison pioneered the PPA model in 2003.

“Wal-Mart has demonstrated a true commitment to energy conservation, reduction of energy costs, and lowering greenhouse gas emissions,” said Jigar Shah CEO of SunEdison. “We look forward to moving ahead with the project and working with Wal-Mart to determine how to best reach their renewable energy goals. These simplified solar-powered energy services also make business sense. Wal-Mart can lower its energy costs with predictable long term energy pricing.”

The total Wal-Mart solar power pilot project is for 22 combined Wal-Mart locations in Hawaii and California. SunEdison was the only vendor selected to service both Hawaii and California, and was awarded the largest number of stores in the competitive bid.
